Subject: Eligibility of party – Canadian Nationalist Party / Parti Nationaliste Canadien

Dear Travis M. Patron:

I am writing to inform you that the review of the application to register the “Canadian Nationalist Party / Party Nationaliste Canadien” has been completed. The party has met the requirements of the *Canada Elections Act* and will be eligible to be registered for the upcoming general election if the writs are issued on or after September 9, 2019.

An eligible party becomes registered when it endorses at least one candidate whose nomination has been confirmed by a returning officer in a general election or in a by-election, as long as it made an application to become registered at least 60 days before the issue of the writ or writs for that election. Your party’s application was complete on July 10, 2019, when you submitted the last required element under subsection 385(2), the policy for the protection of personal information. As such, your party may become registered if it endorses a candidate at an election for which the writs are issued on or after September 9, 2019.

Also, please note that pursuant to subsection 389(2) of the Act, your party may lose its eligibility to become registered for several reasons, including the failure to inform Elections Canada of any changes in the information submitted with your application for registration within 30 days of the change, other than information concerning party members. In this regard, it is essential that you study sections 391 to 408 of the Act thoroughly.

In accordance with section 391 of the Act, your party must, within 30 days after being informed of its eligibility, provide the Chief Electoral Officer with a written report, certified by its leader or chief agent. This report must contain the name and address of any person appointed as a registered agent, with the responsibility for accepting contributions to and incurring and paying expenses of the party, and any terms and conditions to which the appointment is subject. If no registered agents have been appointed, I would appreciate receiving from your party a notice to this effect within 30 days of your receipt of this letter.

Enclosed for your information is an excerpt of the *Canada Elections Act* as it pertains to the obligations and entitlements of political parties.

The provisions concerning the issue of income tax receipts by political parties for contributions received are found in the *Income Tax Act*. Please find enclosed a copy of Information Circular 75-2R9 published by the Canada Revenue Agency on the subject of political contributions. However, please note that your party will not be able to issue tax receipts for such contributions until you are registered. For further information on the *Income Tax Act*, I would suggest that you contact the Canada Revenue Agency directly.

Finally, I take this opportunity to encourage you to ensure that the content of your party's privacy policy is robust and provides useful information to electors. Parties are always welcome to strengthen statements in their policy. Please note that any subsequent change or addition made to your party's privacy policy must be communicated to Elections Canada and reflected online. You can notify us of changes to your policy by submitting a *General Form – Political Party* (EC 20360).
